

HP Kane-n-Honey

Forage Sorghum Male sterile
(Sorghum bicolor)

HP Kane-n-Honey is a medium maturity sterile hybrid cane type forage with lush green broad leaves and sugar sweet stalks that livestock relish. The sterility of the Kane-n-Honey eliminates the hazards of volunteer regrowth, however, nearby fertile sorghums can pollinate Kane-N-Honey. A minimum isolation distance of 1 mile is recommended to protect the sterility. Stalk size can be varied with population, for larger stalks use lower plant populations, and for finer stems use high seeding rates
