Beefmaster is a mixture of forage grasses and white clover, specially formulated for raising stocker cattle and beef cows and calves. Beefmaster is composed of endophyte-free, soft-leaved tall fescues which have improved palatability and are highly digestible, increasing overall dry matter and nutrient intake compared to traditional tall fescues. Along with soft-leaved tall fescues, the high-quality orchardgrass varieties in Beefmaster are grazing tolerant and maintain their productivity even under close grazing. Highly productive, high-energy forage varieties in Beefmaster provide the nutrients required for rapid weight gain in beef cattle. Beefmaster also contains perennial ryegrass, known for exceptional forage quality and rapid establishment, with improved persistence. Remington, the featured perennial ryegrass, combines the yield and disease resistance of a tetraploid and the density, winterhardiness and grazing tolerance of a diploid. Finally, Beefmaster has Alice - a proven, high-quality, grazing tolerant, large-leaved white clover. Ideal for grazing. Beefmaster is also well-suited for haylage/baleage and hay production.

#### **ADAPTATION - CLIMATE**

As Beefmaster is a complex mixture of cool-season grasses, it performs well in areas where cool-season grasses are grown such as humid, temperate regions of the United States. And, with the addition of drought tolerant varieties, it also performs well in drier areas with irrigation.

#### **ADAPTATION - SOIL**

Beefmaster is adapted to a range of soil conditions. It is suited to both shallow and deep soils with light and heavy texture. It is also adapted to a wide range for fertility and moisture conditions.

## USES

Formulated with highly palatable perennial ryegrass and orchardgrass and improved varieties tolerant to grazing, Beefmaster is ideal as a pasture mixture. In addition, its impressive dry matter production and forage quality make it an excellent selection for haylage/baleage and hay production.

## ESTABLISHMENT

A well-prepared, firm seedbed is ideal for sowing Beefmaster. Use either a Brillion-type seeder or a row-drill to sow. Beefmaster can also be seeded via a no-till drill to thicken up older pastures. To ensure good establishment, a well-balanced starter fertilizer such as 100 lbs/acre of triple 20 should be applied at planting. In moderate climate regions, Beefmaster can be planted in spring or early fall. In regions prone to summer drought, if irrigation is not available, fall sowing is recommended.

## SEEDING RATE

Precision-drilled seeding rate: 25 lb / acre  
No-till seeding rate: 25 - 30 lb / acre  
Broadcast seeding rate: 35 - 40 lb / acre

## MANAGEMENT

Beefmaster performs well under rotational grazing systems - defoliation promotes tillering of the perennial ryegrasses and rest periods allow recovery for the orchardgrasses.
